Population-Based Public Health Nursing Practice

The ultimate goal of all levels of population-based practice is to improve population health Public health interventions may be directed at entire populations within a community, the systems that affect the health of those populations, and/or the individuals and families within those populations known to be at risk Interventions at each of these levels of practice contribute to the overall goal
