The main part or stem of a word is called a root word A root word conveys the essential meaning of the word and frequently indicates a body part With a combining form, the root word and a combining vowel such as i, e, o, or a may be combined with another root word, a prefix, or a suffix to describe a particular structure or condition

Introduction to Medical Terminology

The four types of word parts used to create medical terms are: word roots, combining forms, suffixes, and pre-fixes Guidelines for their use are shown in Table 11 1 A word root contains the basic meaning of the term In medical terminology, this word part usually, but not always, indicates the involved body part For example,
