### **Arabs, Kurds, & Persians**

- Like the Arabs, the Kurds are overwhelmingly Muslim, and the great majority are Sunni; only 5% are Shi'a
- Kurdish Muslims tend to be less strict about certain Islamic practices
- For example, there are fewer laws for how Kurdish women should dress than there are for Iranian and Arab women

argues that the prevailing portrait of Muslims “reduc(es) them all to a special malevolent and unthinking essence” On the other hand, Muslims are also portrayed as somewhat competent

### **Who are the Arabs - Community**

Arabs and the Arabic language played central roles in the spread of Islam The Qur’an, the holy book of the Muslims, is God’s word as transmitted to Muhammad in Arabic The perfection of its language and the fact that Muslims consider its words the words of God (“Allah” in Arabic) make Arabic a sacred language for Muslims

Arabs and Muslims live within the United States surrounded by misconceptions about their culture and religion, both of which seemed foreign to most Americans Arabs, like many immigrant groups who came to the United States, were not exempt from racist accusations They were viewed as a backward, violent, desert-dwelling people

Arabs and Muslims have the lowest favorable/highest unfavorable ratings among the groups covered 2 Note that one in four Americans were either unfamiliar with or not sure of their attitudes toward these two communities 3 There is a deep partisan divide on unfavorable attitudes towards Arabs and Muslims While Democrats

### **Disrupting Islamophobia: Teaching the Social Construction ...**

Arabs and Muslims in the US have been increasingly threatened by anti-Muslim rhetoric, airport screenings, traffic stops, detentions, deportations, and hate crimes (Kaplan, 2006; Gottshalk & Greenberg, 2007) Recent reports estimate that the post-9/11 wars have directly caused the deaths of between 174,000 and 220,000
