Patient-reported experience and outcomes from ...

Overall satisfaction with orthodontic treatment was reported by 96% of respondents, 87% would have orthodontic treatment again if needed, and 91% would recommend treatment to a friend Conclusions: The OPTIQ is a useful patient-reported tool to identify pre-treatment concerns and expectations, treatment experience and outcome Orthodontic treatment

of orthodontic treatment Re-root treatment of teeth with poor unsatisfactory obturation should be considered prior to orthodontic treatment Observation periods prior to moving traumatised teeth orthodontically One of the most important factors when plan-ning orthodontic treatment for a patient who has traumatised their upper incisors is extremely

A quality assessment of orthodontic patient ...

to treatment choices, risks, and alternatives An assessment of the quality of commonly used orthodontic patient information leaflets is lacking Methods: A cross-sectional assessment of patient information leaflets from two international orthodontic societies was undertaken The quality of each leaflet was assessed using the DISCERN instrument

Oral Hygiene Behavior during Fixed Orthodontic ...

Results: Approximately 83% of the patient sought orthodontic treatment for esthetic tooth alignment and 857% reported orthodontic treatment was necessary in their daily lives During orthodontic treatment, 61% of the patients used orthodontic toothbrush, 819% used fluoride toothpaste

How to make billing orthodontics easy
